

Technical Document Clearing Cache

CM/ECF has been tested to work correctly with Netscape 4.x and IE 5.x. Therefore, these examples are for Netscape 4.x and IE 5.x. If you are using other versions of Netscape or IE, the ability to perform these options may or may not follow these instructions.

Netscape: version 4.x

1. **Clearing cache**
Click on **edit** in the menu bar
Select **preferences**
Double click on the **advanced** option
Click on the **cache** option
Click on the **clear Memory Cache** button
Click **ok**
Click on the **Clear Disk Cache** button
Click **ok**
Click **ok** again

If you do a lot of Internet browsing, it is recommended that this procedure be used on a weekly basis.

2. **Ensuring newest web pages are used**
Click on **edit** in the menu bar
Select **preferences**
Double click on the **advanced** option
Click on the **cache** option
Under the "Document in cache is compared to document on network:"
Click on the "every time" button
Click **ok**
Click **ok** again

IE (Internet Explorer) - version 5.x:-

1. **Clearing temporary Internet files**
Click on **Tools** on the menu bar
Click on the **Internet Options**
Under the **General** tab, click on **Delete files,**
Click on the **ok** button

If you do a lot of Internet browsing, it is recommended that this procedure be used on a weekly basis.


2. **Ensuring newest web pages are used**
Click on **Tools** on the menu bar
Click on the **Internet Options**
Under the **General** tab, click on **Settings,**
Under the "Check for newer versions of stored pages:"
Click on the "Every visit to the page" radio button
Click **ok**

How to Clear Cache in Mozilla Browser

Select **Tools > Options** from the menu bar

In the window that appears, click the **“Privacy”** button. (Along the right side)

Select **“Cache”** and click the **“Clear”** button.



*I could not find anywhere to set the browser to ensure that the latest version of a page is presented. Supposedly, just clicking the **“Reload”** button in the browser will automatically grab the latest version of a page.
