RE: WAIVER OF SERVICE OF COPIES OF CERTAIN BANKRUPTCY DOCUMENTS ON THE OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLORADO

Due to the efficiencies brought about by the institution of the Electronic Case Files Procedures, **EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2004**, it will no longer be necessary in any case filed in Colorado under any chapter of the bankruptcy code, for *pro se* debtors or debtors' counsel to provide to the Office of the United States Trustee for the District of Colorado, paper or hard copies of any Petition (Form 1), Schedules (Form 6), Statement of Financial Affairs (Form 7), Chapter 7 Individual Debtor's Statement of Intention (Form 8), Statement of Social Security Number (Form 21) and/or Attorney Fee Disclosure Statement (L.B.F. 102.1), or any amendment(s) to any of the aforementioned documents, as heretofore required by Local Bankruptcy Rule 102(c) and Section, II (C)(4)(d) of the Amended Administrative Procedures for Electronic Case Files, attached to Amended General Procedure Order No. 2001-8, (December 2, 2002).

This waiver of service of copies applies only to the aforementioned documents and is not intended to be a waiver as to the service requirements for any other document or pleading filed in any case. Furthermore this waiver applies only to service of copies on the Office of the United States Trustee for the District of Colorado and does not apply or otherwise alter any other service requirement on any standing or appointed trustee or to any other party in interest in any case.
