GENERAL PROCEDURE ORDER NUMBER 2014-1

---

THIS MATTER arises *sua sponte* upon the need to vacate certain General Procedure Orders (GPOs). Certain GPOs can be vacated because they have been incorporated into the most recent amendments to the Local Bankruptcy Rules, Forms and Appendices. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the following orders in their original or amended versions are vacated effective January 1, 2014:

GPO 2010-2 Waiving service in paper of motions for relief from stay and notices of hearing upon the United States Trustee. (Incorporated into L.B.R. 4001-1.)

GPO 2012-3 Making an electronic filing attorney's master address the official address of record in open cases. (Incorporated into L.B.R. 5005-4.)

GPO 2009-5 Mandatory electronic filing for certain creditors and their agents filing proofs of claim or interest. (Incorporated into L.B.R. 5005-4.)

GPO 2012-4 Requiring attorneys, who are electronic filers, to process all fees to be paid electronically to the court. (Incorporated into Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4App and L.B.R. 5005-4.)

GPO 2013-1 Adoption of minor revisions to rules dealing with Chapter 11 cases, examinations and receivers. (Incorporated into L.B.R. 1007-7 and L.B.Form 1007-7.1; L.B.R. 1015-1; L.B.R. 2004-1; L.B.R. 2081-1; L.B.R. 2081-2; and, L.B.R. 4001-3.)

GPO 2012-6 Requiring the use of the new Chapter 13 plan form. (Incorporated into L.B. Form 3015-1.1.)

GPO 2012-2 Requiring exhibits to be retained and provided to any appellate court according to that court's rules or procedures (Incorporated into L.B.R. 9070-1(a)(3).)

FURTHER ORDERED that this General Procedure Order 2014-1 is effective commencing January 1, 2014.
