Motions for Summary Judgment and Dipositive Motions

In an effort to secure the just, speedy and inexpensive determination of every adversary proceeding, this Court enforces strict compliance with L.B.R. 7056-1 which governs summary judgment motions. All parties are advised to review L.B.R. 7056-1 prior to filing or responding to a motion for summary judgment. Failure to comply with L.B.R. 7056-1 may result in a denial of a motion for summary judgment.

If the parties determine to file a motion for summary judgment or other dispositive motion, the Court encourages that such motions should be filed sufficiently in advance of the trial date so that the Court will have sufficient time to consider and rule on the motions before trial.
